### EAT BIRRIA

For a traditional bowl of birria at Taqueria y Birrieria Las Cuatro Milpas (1526 E Lake St). For a modern form of birria in tacos visit Taco Taxi (1511 E Lake Street). For a trendy form of birria visit La Bodega (2829 Hennepin Ave) where you can find it topped on ramen.

#### MIDTOWN FARMERS MARKET

The Midtown Farmers Market (2225 E Lake St) was founded 20 years ago to assure equitable access to fresh, locally-produced food. The Midtown Farmers Market also became the first in Minnesota to accept SNAP-EBT, pioneering healthy food access for communities beyond South Minneapolis.

### PICK YOUR OWN TREATS AT A PANADERIA


Grab a tray or bag and some tongs to select your own fresh-baked bread at a panaderia!
